

## Carlton Nell

Painter and draftsman Carlton Nell has had solo exhibitions at the Wiregrass Museum of Art in Dothan; the Huntsville Museum of Art; the LaGrange Art Museum in Georgia; the Montgomery Museum of Fine Arts; Nancy Hoffman Gallery in New York; and Thomas Deans Fine Art in Atlanta. He was awarded the Southern Prize Finalist award, and named the Alabama State Fellow by South Arts in 2020. His work has been in dozens of group exhibitions throughout the South and across the country, including at The Amory Show in New York; Art Basel/Miami Beach in Miami; the Birmingham Museum of Art and the Mobile Museum of Art, in Alabama; the San Francisco Fine Art Fair; Art Chicago International Art Fair; the Kentucky Museum of Arts + Design in Louisville; Fay Gold Gallery and Marcia Wood Gallery, in Atlanta; the Columbus Museum of Art in Georgia; and Florida's St. Petersburg Center for the Arts. Nell's work is in the collections of the Jule Collins Smith Museum of Fine Art, Birmingham Museum of Art, Huntsville Museum of Art, Montgomery Museum of Fine Arts, in Alabama; the Lagrange Art Museum in Georgia; the Evansville Museum of Art, Science and History in Indiana; and the U.S. Department of State in Arlington, Virginia. He holds an MFA from Georgia State University and a BFA from Auburn University, where he is Professor emeritus.
